Peter asks women "of all shapes and sizes" to contact him if they are interested in being photographed in the nude. "The women on these pages had never appeared nude in front of a camera before, says Peter, "They all described the experience as liberating."



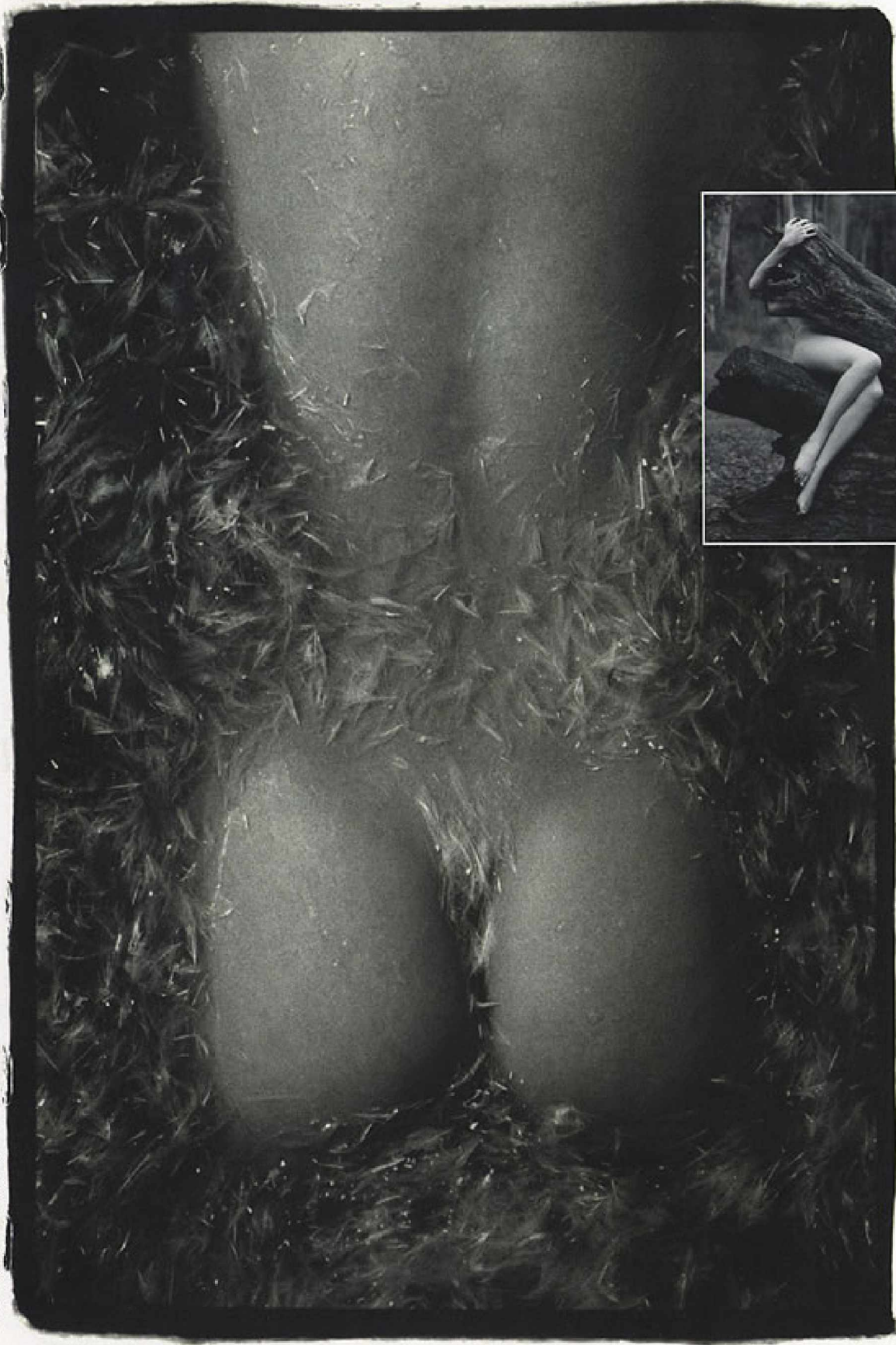
Peter does not pay his subjects, but each woman receives three signed, art-quality prints worth around \$300 – free of charge. "Many people have argued that nude photography is an exploitation of women", says Peter. That's nonsense! Artists have been painting nudes for centuries- Photography is simply a more recent form of art. Of course, like all art, there is both good and bad and much of the good gets lost amongst the bad.

One thing's for sure, any woman appearing in front of my camera does so entirely of her own free will. I can't envisage a situation where any woman could be forced to pose naked against her will. All good nude photography is collaboration between the artist and the subject – my photography is a celebration of the woman."

Before any photography is undertaken, a meeting is arranged (usually at a neutral location like a coffee shop) where the whole process is discussed. Only when his subject is totally confident, will Peter proceed with the photography session.
